How will we use the information you give us?

We will only use your information on the basis that it is necessary to provide you with a quotation, arrange and administer your insurance contract, renewals, adjustments or help you make a claim. We may require special category data from you, such as health or criminal conviction information. We do so on the basis it is in the public interest for insurance to be available to you, and fight crime.

As we are a regulated firm, your data will be used to ensure we meet our legal and regulatory requirements. We also have legitimate interest using your data for business operations to ensure we continue to provide insurance to you.

Where we need to pass information to other firms, it will only be for that purpose. These firms will be Insurers, other insurance brokers, price comparison sites, firms handling claims, and regulatory bodies legal and compliance service providers, fraud agencies and databases. For payments, this includes payment service providers and firms that process or administer our records.

When we contact you, it will either be for the above reason, or because we have a legitimate interest in marketing related products. For any other marketing it will only be with your consent and you will be able to withdraw your consent or unsubscribe easily at any time.

If we have to transfer information to a third country outside the UK/EEA/EU, we will only do so if a similar level of protection applies.

Under to UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR), the lawful bases we rely on for processing your information are detailed in the following table:
